DID YOU KNOW:

By the end of the Second World War around 3.5 million children had experienced evacuation by moving from the cities to the countryside, to keep them safe from German bombs. They would only be allowed to take a small suitcase for their personal belongings, a ration book and a gas mask.

HOW TO MAKE:

You can choose whether you want to colour in your own design or use the one that has already been coloured-in by our graphic designer!


1. Print the PDF and cut out the template.

3. Fold all of the fold lines.
4. Put glue on the glue flaps and stick them to the sides of the bottom panel.
5. Fold the top panel over and fit into the bottom.
